Hackney Community College:
in brief

Success: 10 of the best

- Ofsted graded HCC as a 'Good College' in 2010.
- Our extensive partnerships which strengthen the quality of provision are graded 'Outstanding'.
- Our Mental Health Education and Employment team won a national Beacon Award from the Association of Colleges in 2010.
- We received a glowing report and re-accreditation for the Matrix Standard: the national standard for learning and work-related information and advice.
- We are the only college in London with 'Healthy Colleges' recognition.



- A string of on-court successes places us as the best basketball college in the country.
- Ex-students won Association of Colleges Gold awards for the last two years.

Student success rates have risen steadily over recent years:

- The average point score per student aged 16-18 at level 3 rose by 157.8 points 2008-2010. A2 Level 2010 pass rate was 97%; A*-C grades up 13% on the previous year.
- The BTEC pass rate in 2010 was 99.2%.
- Value Added scores in 2010 show that the progress made by HCC students is significantly above the national average.

Learners

- Around 8,000 in 2009/10, enrolled on over 20,000 courses.
- 80.7% over 19; 16.8% 16-18; 2.5% under 16.
- 55% come from the borough of Hackney.
- 29% come from adjacent boroughs.
- 55% female, 45% male.
- 56% are from Black, Asian and other minority ethnic groups.

Campus

- Our award-winning Shoreditch campus is spacious and secure. In a 2010 learner survey, 96% said they feel safe on campus.
- The City Edge centre in London Fields is our professional business training and events venue.
- Our Open Kitchen restaurant is the perfect place for our London City Hospitality Centre students to train.
- Other professional-standard training facilities include arts and media studios - with brand new media and multimedia equipment; construction and motor vehicle workshops and our sports and performing arts centre.
- Under 5s enjoy the One World Nursery while parents study or work.
- We teach in 40+ community centres and workplaces.
- Hoxton Station on the East London Line is a few hundred metres from our door.

- Courses for ages 14-16, 16-18 and 19+.
- From basic skills to postgraduate courses and everything in between.
- Academic, vocational, professional and courses for fun. (We deliver Adult Safeguarded Learning contracts for Hackney Learning Trust and the City of London.)
- Training for companies of all sizes across all sectors of industry.

International

- We're a leader in international professional development for teachers and education leaders.
- VIPs, ministers and professionals from other countries regularly visit to learn from us. We are currently working successfully to help to develop education practices and capacity in countries including Nigeria, China and Turkey.
- Our students come from across the world.

2012 and beyond

- We embrace the values and opportunities of the 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games and are a proud member of the 2012 Get Set network.
- Students work on and visit the Olympic Park and we are working with partners to make sure that our students can access job opportunities before, during and after the Games in security, hospitality, event roles and more.
- HCC's sports centre (SPACE) has been designated as a Games-time Training Venue. Basketball teams from around the world will be training on our campus in the summer of 2012.



- Our host-borough Legacy Champions project now has three-year funding from London 2012 sustainability partner EDF Energy.
- The host borough colleges' Festival of Sport will run for the third year in 2011.

Money

- Our annual turnover is around £26million.
- Most of our funding comes from the Skills Funding Agency, the Young People's Learning Agency and the Learning Trust.
- We attract other sources of income, through activities that enhance and complement our core business.
- We lease accommodation to partners.
- Most learners' fees are subsidised.
- Many businesses choose our professional service for un-subsidised training.
- The College's financial health has improved for four consecutive years.
